





Increasingly, Māori language and culture play an important role in the workplace and community. These courses offer the opportunity to begin your journey in Te Reo and Tikanga Māori and to enable you to apply your skills confidently and competently in everyday situations.

Introduction to Te Reo and Tikanga MAOR103

Gain an understanding of basic Te Reo and Māori culture and learn how to use your new skills in the workplace and other settings. By arrangement, we can tailor the course to focus on the language you'll most likely use and the situations you'll use it in.

- 10 hours duration

- Available in Christchurch, Timaru and Ashburton, and at your place of business by arrangement

Everyday Te Reo MAOR102

A friendly introduction into Te Reo Māori pronunciation, greetings and farewells. This course will help you get your tongue around Māori names, phrases and vocabulary.

- 3 hours duration
- Suitable for groups of up to 25 people
- \$155 per hour + GST for up to 20 people (additional \$50 for up to five more attendees)
- Available in Christchurch, Timaru and Ashburton, and at your place of business by arrangement
- Participants receive a certificate upon completion

Beginner Te Reo and Tikanga TREO201

Build on your existing skills by learning correct grammar and syntax so you can create well-formed sentences appropriate to the context or situation. A special feature of this course is its live-in Wānanga, which are designed to let you experience Te Reo and Tikanga Māori in authentic settings like Marae, so you 'live' the protocols rather than just learn about them.

- 2 hours per week for 10 weeks (evenings), plus three weekend Wānanga
- Suitable for groups of 15 or more we can create a bespoke experience at times other than the standard scheduled occurrences
- \$150 per person including Wānanga catering and transport to a Marae
- Participants receive a certificate upon completion
- Available in Christchurch, Timaru and Ashburton
